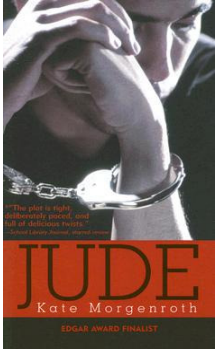


# Are you a **guy** who **doesn't** like to **read**? Try these!



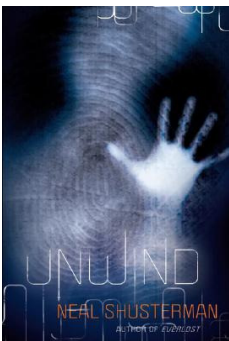
## **Jude** by **K. Morgenroth** **FIC MOR**

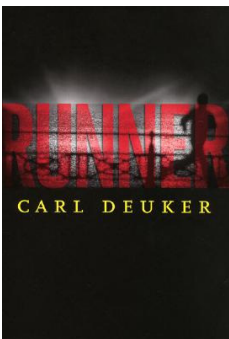
## **Monster** by **Walter Dean Myers** **FIC MYE**

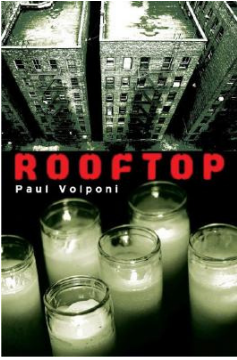
## **Unwind** by **Neal Schusterman** **FIC SCH**

## **Runner** by **Carl Deuker** **FIC DEU**

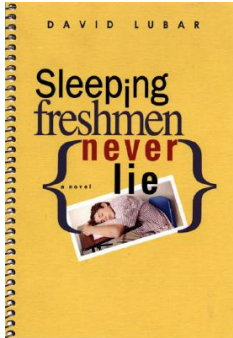

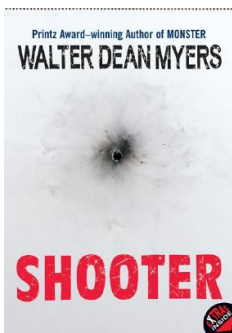

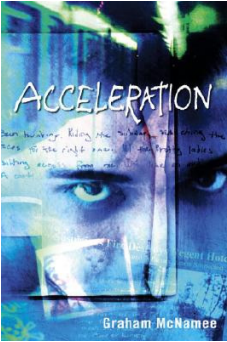
Written in the form of interviews, reports, and journal entries, the story of three troubled teenagers ends in a tragic school shooting.



**The Hunger Games by Suzanne Collins**

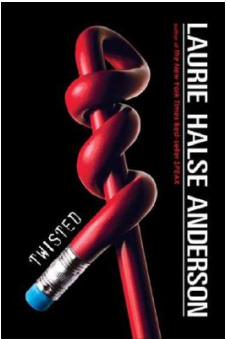

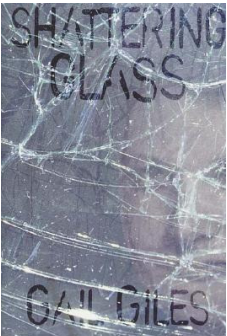
**Acceleration by Graham McNamee**

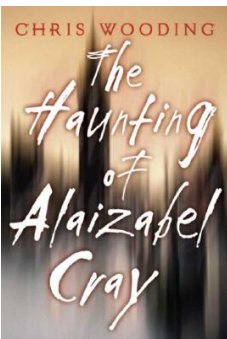
**Twisted by Laurie Halse Anderson**

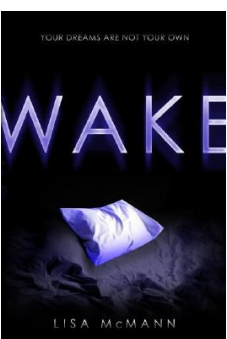
**Shattering Glass by Gail Giles**

When Rob, the charismatic leader of the senior class, turns the school nerd into Prince Charming, his actions lead to unexpected violence.



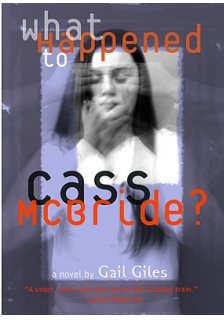
**The Haunting of Alazabel Cray by Chris Wooding**

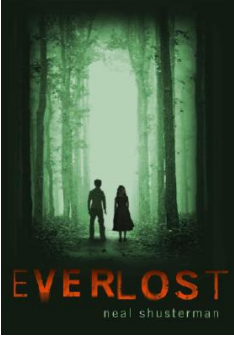

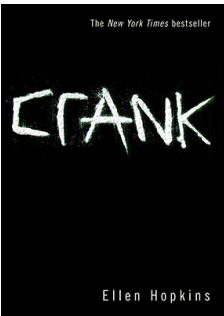
After his younger brother commits suicide, Kyle Kirby decides to exact revenge on the person he holds responsible.

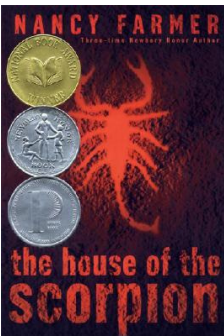

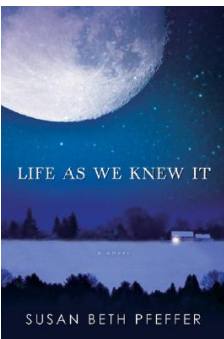
