I just twisted two wires to the two terminals of my organ speaker. I did not use any solder or any thing permanent, fearing that I may void the warranty. Remember to secure this loose wire to the organ frame otherwise it may get pulled out accidentally. I have used a cable-tie and some thumb tacks to secure it.

The end of the first wire goes to my +R input of the subwoofer and the second one goes to the -R input. I then used a two very short wire to join terminals +R and +L, -R and -L. I am not sure if shorting the terminals with two short wires are actually necessary.

Hope this helps.
